Discover Yours: Forest's enormous spatial imaging and powerful yet controlled bass are on display when paired with superior amplification and in larger rooms. Soundstage and bass ability are dialed to 11 in the Wind. To truly appreciate the significant differences, Wind demands reference amplification, large rooms, and plenty of space around it. Give it the right room and amplifier and you can enjoy the definitive Totem experience.

Driver Compliment and Crossover Design: Forest is a two-way design featuring a 1" tweeter and 6.5" woofer. Wind is a unique Totem 3-way design, featuring a 4-driver array consisting of an 8.5" woofer, dual 5.5" midranges, and a 1" tweeter. It's dual 5.5" midranges are the only ones in the Totem line-up, providing supreme performance in this critical spectrum.

Bass extension: Forest drops to 30Hz, while Wind blows down to 24Hz.

Impedance: Forest is an 8 Ohm load, Wind is a more demanding 4 Ohm load.

Amplifier requirements: Forest requires 50-200w from a good amplifier. Wind demands 80-250w from a superior amplifier.
