**Discover Yours:** Hawk addresses the **discerning listener on a budget**. Hawk doesn't require the most powerful amplification but when **paired to reference level electronics**, it **delivers reference level performance**.

Forest has all the heritage features and design elements of a Totem column but is dialed up to 11. Possesses the bass punch of a heavyweight in a middleweight body. Forest's unrivaled, **enormous spatial imaging** is truly at its **brehtaking best** when **appropriately powered and in a larger room**. Master of all types of music and multi-channel applications.

**Power Handling:** Hawk is rated at **30-120w**. Forest handles 75% more power, **50-200w**.

**Impedance:** Hawk is a **6 Ohm** load and **thrives with powerful amplifiers**. Forest's **8 Ohm** load makes it easier to drive **but needs at least 50 watts** from a good amp to realize the full breadth of its abilities.

**Woofer:** Hawk's **5.5" extreme long throw** woofer and **patented magnet system** descend to **32Hz**. Forest employs a larger, more formidable **6.5" woofer** and drops to **30Hz**.
