Both models possess KIN Play designations but possess several key differences as well.

Design characteristics: KIN Play combines an **extremely powerful amplifier** and substantial though **moderately sized monitor** enclosure for a powered speaker system that **can fill very large rooms** with stunning listening levels. It easily and quite conveniently replaces a good integrated amplifier and passive speaker combination.

KIN Play Mini provides the **same feature set** as the bigger, award winning KIN Play, just in a slightly lower powered, **compact form that fits virtually anywhere**. It shines in **mid sized rooms** and can even work in larger rooms for those who do not necessarily seek to attain the same high volume output of the KIN Play.

Amplifier: KIN Play's powerful amplifier puts out a staggering **120 watts** to two channels at 4 ohm. The KIN Play Mini amplifier is rated at **70 watts**.

Woofer and Bass Extension: KIN Play features a **5" woofer** and can descend all the way down to **39Hz**. KIN Play Mini is equipped with a **4" woofer** of the same overall design and plays down to **59Hz**.

Dimensions: KIN Play's dimensions are (WxHxD) **7.08" x 13.97" x 9.25"**, and the combined weight of the pair is **28 pounds**.

KIN Play Mini's dimensions are almost **30% smaller** at **6.37" x 10.62" x 7.48"**, and over **35% lighter** at just over **18 pounds** per pair. Still quite substantial, but diminutive next to its big brother.
