The Sky Center replaces the Rainmaker Center and provides the following improvements.

Design characteristics: Like a race car needs high octane gas and performance tires, **Rainmaker Center** requires superior components and source material to truly shine.

SKY Center harmonizes more easily and organically with a wider choice of electronics to satisfy the audiophile, movie enthusiast, and gamer alike.

Woofer and Bass Extension: The **Rainmaker Center** has 5.5" woofers and descends to 44Hz. **SKY Center** features a customized version of the 5.75" woofer found in the SKY Tower and descends to 42Hz.

Tweeter: **Rainmaker Center's** 1" aluminum dome tweeter is detailed and precise, but also reveals the shortcomings of poor recordings. **SKY Center's** 1.3" soft dome tweeter is equally detailed but more forgiving to average recordings and sources. It extends low enough to contribute to the critical midrange and has superior off axis performance for better placement versatility.

Power Handling: **Rainmaker Center** is rated at 30-120w. **SKY Center** is rated at 20-150w, so it's easier to drive and handles more power.

Sensitivity: **Rainmaker Center** is rated at 87.5dB, demanding superior electronics to perform to its full potential. **SKY Center** is rated at 90dB, makes it suitable for a much wider variety of electronics, from modest integrated amps to high powered surround systems.
